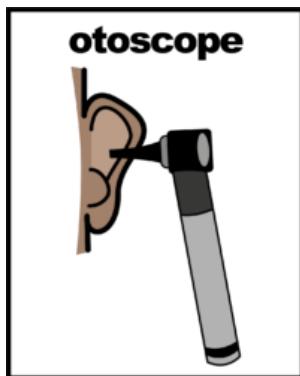


What happens at an Annual Health Check?

The equipment used to help the doctor see into your ear is called an otoscope.



The doctor or nurse is checking that;




- There is not too much wax in your ear,


